- During the week of July 4th, NEWGLSF also holds the annual Salmon Derby at the Manitowoc Marina; this will be our 44th Annual Derby. Northeast members are also eligible for special prizes for the largest fish in each category provided by sponsoring lure manufacturers.
- Another thing for our Member Fishermen is our “Free” Year-Long Fishing Contest. The club's contest is divided into 5 time periods with over \$4,000 worth of prizes for the 3 largest fish registered in each of the five major categories for each of the time periods.
